

American Rescue Plan Act 2021 (ARP) Quarterly Report for Student Portion

For the Period Ending September 30, 2021

The American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARP) (Pub. L. 117-2) (March 11, 2021), authorizes the Secretary of Education to provide emergency financial aid grants to institutions of higher education. Uses of this funding are governed by section 2001(b)(1) of the ARP. Illinois College Pell recipients in order to receive an emergency financial aid grant.

Illinois College will administer these funds in accordance with its "Funding Certification and Agreement for the Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CARES Act," dated April 10, 2020, as amended by the U.S. Department of Education on January 17, 2021 and again on May 19, 2021.

Illinois College also received "Institutional Portion" CRRSAA funding. Allowable uses under the ARP and CRRSAA Acts for Institutional Portion awards include:

- Defraying expenses associated with coronavirus (including lost revenue, reimbursement for expenses already incurred, technology costs associated with a transition to distance education, faculty and staff trainings, and payroll);
- Making additional emergency financial grants to students, which may be used for any component of the student's cost of attendance or for
